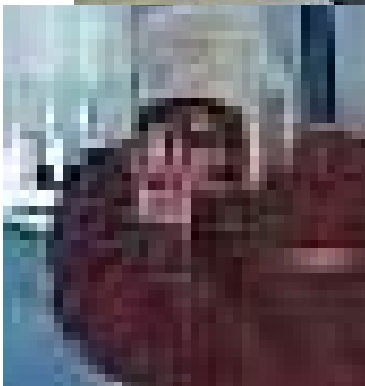

## Pharmacy Robbery:

**YORK COUNTY:** On Friday morning (5-28), a white male between 25 and 35 years old, ROBBED the Saco Rite Aid on Main St. The suspect was between 5'10" and 6' tall, with a slim build, brown hair and brown eyes. His facial appearance was described as tanned, dirty or both. His skin also appeared to be weathered with several day's growth of facial hair. He was wearing a maroon pullover jacket with writing on the left breast area. He also wore a gray hooded sweatshirt and a black shirt underneath. It's possible he was also wearing a dark ball cap under the hooded sweatshirt. The police have not disclosed the amount of prescription meds that were taken in the incident. ## Bank Robbery Arrest:

**CENTRAL MAINE:** Friday afternoon (5-28), the Bank of America branch on Bangor St. in Augusta was robbed by a man who appeared to be in his 50's or 60's. He handed the teller a note demanding money, and left with an undisclosed amount of cash. No weapon was shown during the incident. Police K-9 'Koda' assisted in the search. A short time later a tip was received that a man fitting the suspect's description was walking on the banks of the Kennebec River. **STEPHEN LONG**, 59 years old of Augusta, was located and taken into custody by Augusta PD. He was intoxicated and admitted to his role in the robbery. All the stolen cash was found in a duffle bag he was carrying at the time of the arrest.

## Portland Armed Bank Robbery:

**PORTLAND:** The Bank of America Branch at 446 Forest Ave. in Portland was robbed last Wednesday afternoon (5-26) by a subject who displayed a handgun and demanded money. He is described as a white male, 35-40 years old, 6'2" tall and approximately 225 lbs. He had brown hair, a short beard, and was wearing a white t-shirt and baseball cap. He fled with an undisclosed amount of cash. Police are in the process of interviewing other customers who were in the bank at the time of the incident. ## Attempt to Pass Fraudulent Prescriptions:

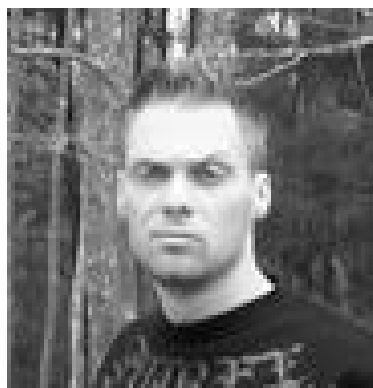
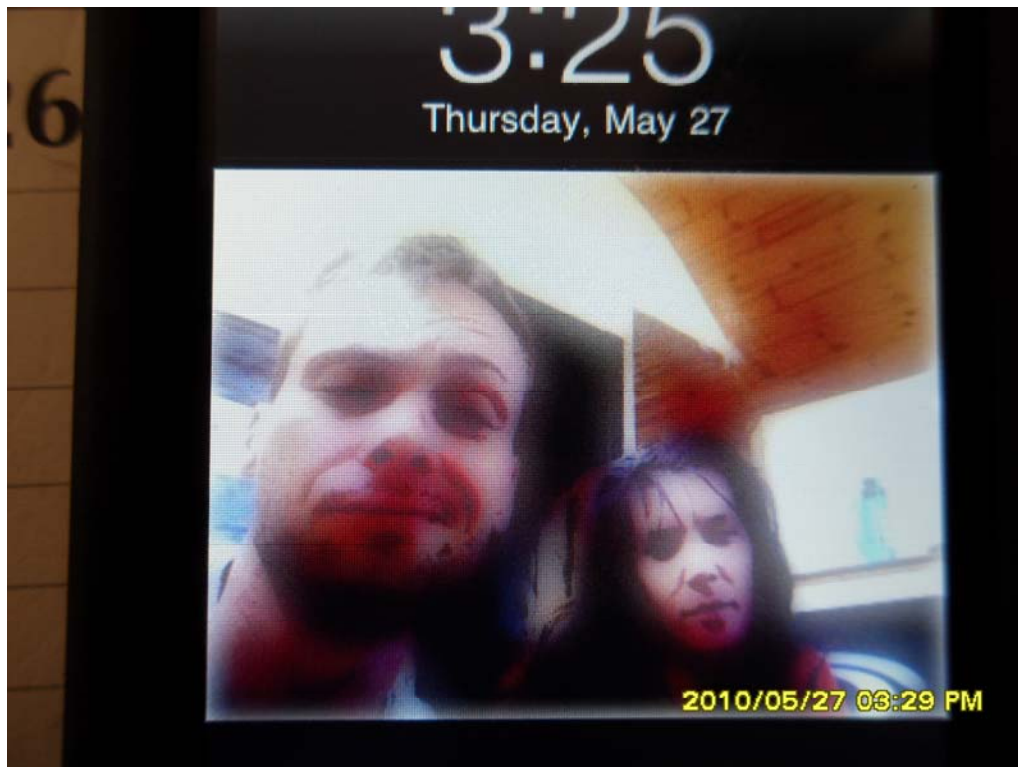

**SOUTHERN/COASTAL MAINE:** The subject shown in the photo below walked into a Dialysis Center in Ellsworth on Thursday (5-27) and grabbed a purse before fleeing. Unfortunately for him, he dropped his Ipod ITouch as he was committing the theft. The phone has a picture of him and a female on it (below) and came back to 772-7966, an apartment in Portland.

This rocket scientist has been identified as **BROCK COCHRAN**, 30 years old of Portland. Cochran has been highlighted many times on previous bulletins and is known for thefts from college campuses & businesses. **SOUTHERN MAINE:** South Portland PD is attempting to identify the emblem on the back of the sweatshirt shown below. The picture is of a blue plow truck and the name appears to start with 'M'; however the rest is not readable. The subjects used a credit card at Sears in the Maine Mall, but the card holder was a lifelong resident of Stowe (MA).....and died 5 months before the card was used. **SOUTHERN MAINE:** South Portland PD advises they have had numerous contacts with **LUQMAN JONES**, 27 years old, usually at area hotels and motels, involving drug violations and/or prostitution.

Jones (who lives in Portland) was arrested last week at a South Portland hotel with 3 men from Brooklyn (NY) and charged with AGGRAVATED TRAFFICKING IN A CLASS W DRUG. A loaded firearm was also found in the room. The hotel rooms are usually rented by someone other than Jones (usually a female) and it's unknown how far out of the Portland/South Portland area they are targeting. ## Upcoming Explorer Academy:
